Investigating the effect of the novel 'LAZY4D' point mutation on protein stability and subcellular targeting using transient protein expression in *Nicotiana benthamiana*. Preparation and sterilisation of plant tissue culture media. Growing and maintaining *N. benthamiana* and *Arabidopsis thaliana* plants in tissue culture glasshouses. Transient infiltration of *N. benthamiana*. Protein extraction and western blotting. Live cell confocal microscopy and image analysis.
